- Assure ongoing reporting of adverse events to the Sponsor, IRB/ECs and DSMB
- Lead the company's clinical data management activities from protocol development and review, through CRF and database design, trial conduct, and database lock
- Define and refine clinical procedures and standards, all in accordance with GCP and SOPs
- Ensure compliance with GCP, FDA, Health Canada, and IRB/EC requirements
- Contribute to regulatory FDA and Health Canada submissions, including IDEs, supplements and 510(k) market clearance applications
- Contribute to product development by working with R&D team and communicating clinical insights

Education, Experience and Training:

- The successful candidate should have a BS/BA in life science, engineering or equivalent combination of education and experience. Advanced degree preferred. Additional course work or certifications in specific areas a plus (i.e., ASQC, RAC, ACRP)
- At least 5 years of experience in medical device clinical operations, including direct support of clinical trial sites
- Experience in urology and regulatory activities desired but not required
- Excellent attention to detail and ability to coordinate multiple activities simultaneously
